## You have been prescribed Domnisol<sup>®</sup>.

Domnisol is used to treat or prevent low levels of vitamin D (insufficiency or deficiency) in adults. Always take this medicine as prescribed by your healthcare professional.

This medicine should not be taken daily.



## Treatment dose

Take one capsule, once monthly, as prescribed by your healthcare professional.

**How can you remember to take your treatment?**

**How many capsules will I receive from the pharmacy?**

- Domnisol is available in the UK as a one or three capsule pack.
